The death of our Ambassador to Libya Chris Stevens could have been prevented had the State Department acted on <u>information</u> they had received.



Our Founders knew that our security and the means to provide it would always be determined by the threats facing our nation. To use any other barometer for determining defense and foreign policy was completely unacceptable.

"If one nation maintains constantly a disciplined army, ready for the service of ambition or revenge, it obliges the most pacific nations who may be within the reach of its enterprises to take corresponding precautions." James Madison, Federalist 41

In a world filled with evil people, we do not have the luxury of living in the makebelieve world of "All I am saying is give peace a chance." It might make for a nice song by John Lennon but it can never be embraced as national security or foreign policy. We must be ever vigilant to protect our people from all enemies, foreign and domestic.

Whether or not our elected leaders want to admit it, Islam is at war with America and all liberty-loving people. And when we know that either a nation, religion, or peoples are at war with us, have openly declared war against us, then we must understand we are at war with them. That truth can only be rejected at the expense of our safety and our liberty. That is anathema to what our Founding Fathers envisioned at the Constitutional Convention in 1787. Read again the Preamble to our Constitution:

The Preamble outlines the purpose of our federal government. In light of recent events in the Middle East, among many others, it is clear this administration has failed its constitutional duties.
