"There are particular moments in public affairs when the people, stimulated by some irregular passion, or some illicit advantage, or misled by the artful misrepresentations of interested men, may call for measures which they themselves will afterwards be the most ready to lament and condemn." James Madison, [*Federalist #63*](#)

Democrat leaders from Obama, Biden, Holder, DeBlasio, Sharpton, and Jackson had a rare opportunity to prove themselves true American patriots, who perhaps disagreeing on Republican policy, still were concerned with the public's safety and welfare.

Instead, they have chosen to demagogue the situation, primarily casting aspersions on our first responders. Go back and reread Madison's quote from *Federalist #63*. Is that not the exact description of the behavior exhibited by Democrat leaders?

Notice closely the first charge brought against King George III in our Declaration of Independence:

Our nation was founded on biblical principles; to deny this is to deny the truth. I guess that is why the secular humanists do indeed reject this truth. Facts always offend liberals and stymie all their aspirations and motives.

Pastor Wilkerson has nailed the root problem of America: we have casted aside the Bible and rebelled “against the restraints of Scripture.”

So why has this happened, or better yet, how? We can go back in time to December 4, 1873 to find the answer:

“I am persuaded that the fault is more in the ministry and public press than in any and all things else...The proper guardians of the public conscience have, I fear, very much neglected to expound and insist upon obedience to the moral law.” Charles G. Christians, conservatives, and Republicans, or all three-in-one, have lamented loudly over media bias. Furthermore WE the People, particularly Christian citizens, must do the same. We ring our hands over the attacks on Christmas specifically and Christianity in general, all the while we should also be standing in the gap.

Of course we’ve seen small business owners being “forced” by the government to provide goods and services to customers they rightly refuse. However the body of Christ needs to rise up mightily against any lawlessness attempted to be forced upon us by the government. That is how we started as a republic.

TO THE STREETS

So how do we stop the rapid spread of lawlessness overtaking our republic and violating our individual liberties? Here are some suggestions:

1. Be sure that you are a law-abiding citizen. Obey all the laws, not just the ones you don't consider inconvenient. Of course we are to reject man's law if it violates God's law, but we must first fight to repeal or replace it. We cannot become that which we abhor.
2. Keep a close watch on how crime is dealt with in your community. If your mayor, chief of police, sheriff, and other officials are soft on crime, then replace them with those who will maintain law and order. Remember, all politics are local.
3. Follow closely how your county and state representatives deal with lawlessness. If they are promoting unacceptable behaviors such as we are witnessing across America, particularly towards our police, then replace them.
4. Let your US Representative and two US Senators know that you expect them to pass only laws that do not violate God's laws, the Declaration of Independence, and the US Constitution (in that order) and that they need to repeal all laws that violate either of the three.
5. Contact [NYC](#) Bill de Blasio and the NYC Convention and Visitor's [Bureau](#) and let them know that you will be avoiding New York City until the mayor resigns.
6. Call your local talk radio station and write a letter to the editor of your local newspaper and voice your opposition to the rampant lawlessness across the country. Let's begin the conversation and raise the awareness of the danger that lawlessness is to liberty.

There are many ways we can ensure law and order are maintained. First and foremost our law enforcement officers must respect the law and the rights of citizens. We should never allow lawlessness from those entrusted with protecting the public.

Let's begin Year 2015 returning back to the Founders' intent of Year 1776.
