It's no secret that liberals love to party; especially on the

tax payers' dime. Barack Obama's penchant for the jet-setting life has been well documented. Breitbart.com reports from a forthcoming study from the National Taxpayer Union Foundation (NTUF) that Obama is "The most internationally well-traveled President, through five years, is also flying the most expensive-to-operate Air Force One to date."

The mission statement of the General Services Administration (GSA) states, "The mission of GSA is to deliver the best value in real estate, acquisition, and technology services to government and the American people."

A close look at the <u>listed</u> GSA priorities goes into further detail on its mission.

Number 6 particularly caught my eye:

It shouldn't be too much of a stretch for any voter's imagination to believe that the level of opulence lavished upon not only presidents, but also members of Congress, was not the type of government for which the American Revolution was fought.

So what is our remedy? Our 16th President Abraham Lincoln has the answer:

This country, with its institutions, belongs to the people who inhabit it. Whenever they shall grow weary of the existing government, they can exercise their constitutional right of amending it, or their revolutionary right to dismember or overthrow it.

The only question is: will WE the People exercise those rights?

The extravagant living of our elected officials in no way benefits WE the People or the United States.

"Government is, or ought to be, instituted for the common benefit and security of the people, nation or community; whenever any government shall be found inadequate or contrary to these purposes, a majority of the community hath an indubitable, unalienable, indefeasible right, to reform, alter, or abolish it, in such manner as shall be judged most conducive to the public Weal." <u>Virginia Declaration of Rights</u>, drafted by George Mason, (original quotation spelling kept).

One of the <u>indictments</u> against King George III found in the Declaration of Independence is "He has erected a multitude of New Offices, and sent hither swarms of Officers to harrass our people, and eat out their substance."

This is the type of government the United States has, and while it certainly was not initiated by Barack Obama, he has multiplied the federal tyrannical power exponentially. Whenever government grows, the tax burden upon the citizens also grows. When the people are ignored as has been the case in the last 8 years, then the government is once again guilty of "imposing Taxes on us without our Consent" (another indictment found in our Declaration of Independence).

Go back and read the list of indictments in our Declaration and see if present and past governments are not guilty of the detailed offenses found in our nation's birth certificate. We separated from England because of those violations of our unalienable rights. We fought a bloody revolution, stumbled as a nation in its genesis under the inadequacy of the Articles of Confederation, and finally came up with a God-inspired document, the US Constitution, to prevent ever having to face what our Founders did. We have failed to do what Benjamin Franklin said in answer to a woman's inquiry about our new government:

[&]quot;A republic, if you can keep it."

"That ever-memorable day, the nineteenth of April, is the date of an unhappy war openly begun by the ministers of the king of Great Britain against his good subjects in this colony, and implicitly against all the other colonies. But for what? Because they have made a noble stand for their natural and constitutional rights, in opposition to the machinations of wicked men who are betraying their royal master, establishing Popery in the British dominions, and aiming to enslave and ruin the whole nation, that they may enrich themselves and their vile dependents with the public treasures and the spoils of America." Samuel Langdon, "Government Corrupted by Vice and Recovered by Righteousness" sermon, Watertown, Massachusetts, May 31, 1775.

Quite a long quote from Samuel Langdon, however it gives great insight into the minds of our Founding Fathers. When our American ancestors took a stand for their God-given unalienable rights, they were attacked by the British. Thus began the War for Independence.

Many are the examples and laments found in Scripture of God's people being oppressed by tyrants. When Rehoboam became king after his father Solomon had died, the elders came to him and implored of him:

"Your father made our yoke heavy; now therefore, lighten the burdensome service of your father, and his heavy yoke which he put on us, and we will serve you." (1 Kings 12:4)

Both Solomon and Rehoboam ignored the godly advice of their father David:

"Do not trust in oppression, nor vainly hope in robbery; if riches increase, do not set your heart on them." (Psalm 62:10)

As long as we keep electing men and women to public office who do not first obey God's laws, and respect the Declaration of Independence and US Constitution, we will continue to be oppressed by our government. We need to obey the warning of the Prophet Zechariah:

"Do not oppress the widow or the fatherless, the alien or the poor. Let none of you plan evil in his heart against his brother." (Zechariah 7:10)
