



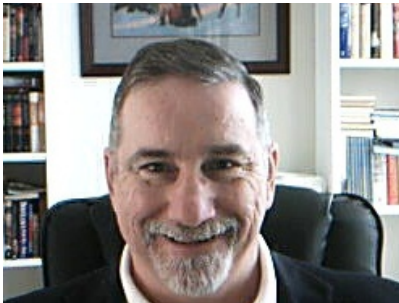

In fact for most leftists, our lack of

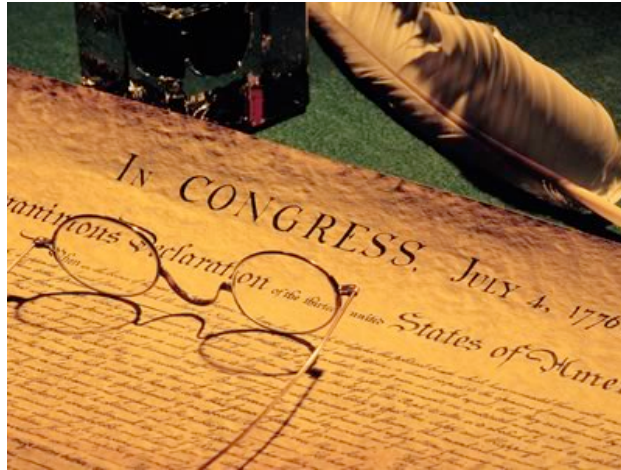
industrial progress is the only thing they embrace relative to our founding.

FROM THE FOUNDERS



Our Founding Fathers expected government to “ensure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defence, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity.” Part of that expectation was that government would not keep us from our natural resources.

“It is too early for politicians to presume on our forgetting that the public good, the real welfare of the great body of the people, is the supreme object to be pursued; and that no form of government whatever has any other value than as it may be fitted for the attainment of this object.” James Madison - Federalist Paper #45

A President who goes against the desires of the majority of our elected officials and the will of WE the People is a form of soft tyranny. One of the reasons for the commerce clause in Article I of the US Constitution was states were being denied prosperity because of the limits of the Articles of Confederation. Alexander Hamilton writes in Federalist Paper #11:

An unrestrained intercourse between the States themselves will advance the trade of each by an interchange of their respective productions, not only for the supply of reciprocal wants at home, but for exportation to foreign markets. The veins of commerce in every part will be replenished, and will acquire additional motion and vigor from a free circulation of the commodities of every part. Commercial enterprise will have much greater scope, from the diversity in the productions of different States.

A President who not only denies the people of securing “the Blessing of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity,” but also fails to “provide for the common defence” through his actions or inactions, is unfit for office. By continuing our reliance on oil from nations hostile to our Constitution, Barack Obama has violated the oath of office as designed by WE the People.

If ever there was a time to replace the man in the Oval Office and ninety percent of Congress, both Democrats and Republicans, the time is now. Our Founders gave us the means through our Constitution. Time for WE the People to respond appropriately.

“When you study creation, you study the mind of God. When you protect creation, you protect the work of God. When you admire creation, you admire the goodness of God. God created earth as a place for human beings to dwell. We were created to fellowship with God and with each other. God also gave man dominion over the earth, not to pillage it, but to take care of it. Notice God's actions after creating the Garden of Eden:

“Then the LORD God took the man and put him in the garden of Eden to tend and keep it.” (Genesis 2:15)

As you can read in Pastor Ortberg's [sermon](#), the word “tend”, rendered “work” in some translations, “can be translated, *to serve*.” To tend means *to keep*.

God blesses us and meets our needs through His Creation. And as His highest creation, we are expected to take care of it as God takes care of us. We are good stewards of our belongings because we know it is God who provides it.

You show me a Christian who is not a good steward of all that God has given him or her and I will show you someone who does not love God fully. We should want to keep God's creation in top shape for when He returns to it.

Environmentalists will tell you human beings are no more important than any other species on earth. That is not the aletheia truth; the Bible tells us differently.

These same environmentalists are keeping our nation in bondage to hostile oil-producing nations by working to stop any and all oil drilling. In fact, in some extreme cases they want us to never use another petroleum-based product.

These are the type of people who worship Mother Earth. Why worship the created when you can worship the Creator?
