# FROM THE FOUNDERS



**Congress has passed legislation that not only did not originate from the House of Representatives as is constitutionally required, but they also have exempted themselves from the burden of such law.**

“What is to restrain the House of Representatives from making legal discriminations in favor of themselves and a particular class of the society? I answer: the genius of the whole system; the nature of just and constitutional laws; and above all, the vigilant and manly spirit which actuates the people of America, a spirit which nourishes freedom, and in return is nourished by it. If this spirit shall ever be so far debased as to tolerate a law not obligatory on the legislature, as well as on the people, the people will be prepared to tolerate any thing but liberty.” James Madison, [Federalist #57](#)

Senators Reid and McConnell came up with their own continuing resolution to fund the government and increase the debt limit. Speaker of the House Boehner should have rejected this bill outright as unconstitutional. Article I, Section 7 clearly states:

“All Bills for raising Revenue shall originate in the House of Representatives; but the Senate may propose or concur with Amendments as on other Bills.”

Never mind Congress hasn't passed a budget in over 4 years, any spending bills must originate in the House of Representatives. If the Senate disagrees with the bill, they are empowered to offer amendments to the bill. The House and Senate can have a conference to come to an agreement on an appropriate bill.

The Senate, however, does not have the constitutional powers to originate any bills that create revenue for the government. This was done because the Senate represented the states and the House directly represent the people. Now they supposedly do both. Just one more reason to [repeal](#) the 17th Amendment.
