If ever there were a more perfect example of why the IRS should be abolished, the Lois Lerner case is it. The blatant oppressive measures taken by the IRS through at the behest of the Obama Administration is grounds for immediate closing of the IRS and just another impeachment charge against Barack Obama.

My [friend](#) Jerome Corsi, reporting in his latest WorldNetDaily [column](#), details how “Lerner was responding to political pressure in her efforts to clamp down on conservative organizations seeking tax-exempt status in the wake of the 2012 Supreme Court case Citizens United v. Federal Election Commission.”

Barack Obama [made](#) clear his displeasure with the Supreme Court’s ruling during his 2010 State of the Union address. As is his usual style he criticized the court’s ruling

for bringing about what he clearly did in the 2008 election when it comes to foreign campaign money.

In the House Committee report cited by Mr. Corsi, emails revealed the need for a plan to target groups such as the tea party and conservatives. She made sure that this plan had to be covered up to prevent it from appearing as the partisan attack it actually was.

The most onerous of Ms. Lerner’s offenses is that her actions violate those groups constitutional rights, and yet she has no problem invoking her 5th Amendment right against self-incrimination. There is no height of hypocrisy too high for leftists.

FROM THE FOUNDERS



Barack Obama has committed “a long train of abuses and usurpations” in achieving his ultimate goal of a soft tyranny of socialist rule. If King George III and his Parliament were able to see the despotism Americans live under today, they would have to wonder why we ever revolted against them.

“Such has been the patient sufferance of these Colonies; and such is now the necessity which constrains them to alter their former Systems of Government. Pastor Cofield is absolutely right. The pulpits in America have been silent on what is good and right for far too long. The pastors have hidden under their pulpits in fear of the IRS and now groups who are trying to defend the Constitution that gives pastors their religious freedom are being attacked by the IRS.

What if pastors all across America were to stand in the pulpits, call our current government evil, and encourage their flocks to call Washington DC and demand accountability? “The church must take right ground in regard to politics. Do not suppose, now, that I am going to preach a political sermon, or that I wish to have you join and get up a Christian party in politics. No, I do not believe in that. But the time has come that Christians must vote for honest men, and take consistent ground in politics, or the Lord will curse them... God cannot sustain this free and blessed country, which we love and pray for, unless the church will take right ground. Politics are a part of religion in such a country as this, and Christians must do their duty to the country as a part of their duty to God.”

It’s hard to believe that Reverend Finney wrote these lectures, which were from his sermons, back in 1835. That is some 180 years ago, and yet his words ring truer today than when he wrote them nearly 200 years ago.

If Congressman Darrell Issa receives lots of encouraging letters and phone calls, perhaps he will know he has the support of the American people.
