



## FROM THE FOUNDERS



It is not a 21st Century phenomenon that our politics have become so malicious. Our Father of the Country, the First President of the United States, lamented on the nastiness of political conversation, particularly in the media.

"I would fain hope that liberal allowances will be made for the political opinions of one another; and instead of those wounding suspicions, and irritating charges with which some of our Gazettes are so strongly impregnated, & cannot fail if persevered in, of pushing matters to extremity, & thereby tare the Machine asunder, that there might be mutual forbearances and temporising yieldings on all sides. Without these I do not see how the Reins of Government are to be managed, or how the Union of the States can be much longer preserved.." George Washington, in a <u>letter</u> to Alexander Hamilton, August 26, 1792.

That is a longer quote than I usually use on this page, but it is very poignant. The whole letter is worthy of your 10 minutes it would take to read. Washington wrote that he knew political opinions were unavoidable and that they might even be necessary. However, he regretted that political "subjects cannot be discussed with temper on the one hand, or decisions submitted to without having the motives which led to them, improperly implicated on the other." It bothered Washington that men who he knew to be true patriots were resorting to the mudslinging that has become common practice in politics.

Washington feared that our form of government would not survive if the media and politicians were continually tearing each other apart.

He also did not want to believe that any "internal obstructions" would be deliberate by any party or news organization.

Mr. President, your greatest fears have come true and are running amok. Without a true national repentance, I too fear that our "Union of States can be much longer preserved."
