

WE the People are responsible for the government we get. The old cliché of

you get the government you deserve is never better applied than to protecting voter integrity. Voter fraud is the antithesis of voter integrity and the only antidote for voter fraud is voter ID laws.



FROM THE FOUNDERS



To imagine the Founding Fathers would have allowed voting without proof of citizenship is to engage in delusional thinking. Nothing could be further from the Truth. In fact, the Founders did not want non-property owners to vote because of the mess we are in today. However, they knew citizens should have the right to vote. Showing a picture ID is not asking too much of voters.

"The right of suffrage is a fundamental Article in Republican Constitutions. The regulation of it is, at the same time, a task of peculiar delicacy. Allow the right exclusively to property, and the rights of persons may be oppressed. The feudal polity alone sufficiently proves it. Extend it equally to all, and the rights of property or the claims of justice may be overruled by a majority without property, or interested in measures of injustice. Of this abundant proof is afforded by other popular Govts and is not without examples in our own, particularly in the laws impairing the obligation of contracts." James Madison, Federal Convention of 1787, from his "Speech on the Right of Suffrage."

There are no viable excuses for opposing voter IDs. It is a ploy by the Left to once again put conservatives on the defensive (which is working with Rand Paul), and to obfuscate the real issue at hand: voter integrity.

Democrats are invested in stealing elections. From the salacious Secretary of State <u>Project</u>, to open voter <u>fraud</u>, and many other attempts to stuff the ballot box, liberals know that the only guarantee for election night victory is to defraud the electorate.

Liberals know that their failed policies are no longer acceptable to the large majority of the electorate. They lie about their intentions, falsely accuse Republicans of voter intimidation through voter ID laws, and when all else fails, they cheat.

"The government, early established in the world among the ancient Hebrews, was a free republic like ours, the sovereignty resided in the body of the people. They were to choose able men; and they were called to give their assent to the laws given from Heaven, before they were put into execution. When government is thus founded, according to the divine mind, and rulers chosen, they become representatives of the power and majesty of God; and important instruments employed by his providence and grace, in the administration of affairs in this lower world." The Reverend Daniel Foster, from his election sermon, May 26, 1790.

Voting is the most sacred act we perform as citizens of the United States. All we who call ourselves Christians will give an account for whom we chose to be our leaders. The responsibility to put only godly men and women in public office was established long ago:

"Moreover you shall select from all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them to be rulers of thousands, rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens." (Exodus 18:20)

If we allow our elections to be stolen for fear of being called a racist or accused of voter intimidation, then we deserve to lose this great nation.
