

FROM THE FOUNDERS



While Alexis de Tocqueville was not a Founding Father, he is considered one of the earliest and accurate social scientist to explain the uniqueness of the American republic. He placed high importance to the role of religion.

"Religion in America...must be regarded as the foremost of the political institutions of that country; for if it does not impart a taste for freedom, it facilitates the use of it. Indeed, it is in this same point of view that the inhabitants of the United States themselves look upon religious belief." Alexis de Tocqueville, <u>Democracy in America</u>

As a Christian, I greatly wrestled with the thought of voting for a man such as Donald Trump. I try to use <u>Exodus 18:21</u> as my standard for selecting a leader, but in the case of this year's presidential race, I am not afforded that luxury.

Of course I could choose to not vote for someone who does not meet the above biblical standard, however, I do not believe that to be an option this election cycle.

At stake is religious liberty. Tocqueville, as do others, would make the case that without religion, liberty cannot truly exist. Liberty is a Christian principle. Listen to Tocqueville:

"I do not know whether all Americans have a sincere faith in their religion—for who can search the human heart?—But I am certain that they hold it to be indispensable to the maintenance of republican institutions. This opinion is not peculiar to a class of citizens or a party, but it belongs to the whole nation and to every rank of society."

Clearly, that is no longer true of America. Religion, specifically Christianity, is under attack by a growing faction of atheists, God-haters, militant homosexuals, the mainstream media, and the Democrat Party. That must change if America is to survive.

FROM THE PULPIT

"In reading over the Constitutions of all fifty of our states, I discovered something which some of you may not know: there is in all fifty, without exception, an appeal or a prayer to the Almighty God of the universe... Through all fifty state Constitutions, without exception, there runs this same appeal and reference to God who is the Creator of our liberties and the preserver of our freedoms." Dr. D. James Kennedy, "Church and State" sermon, Ft. Lauderdale, FL, July 16, 1986.
