# FROM THE FOUNDERS



**Fisher Ames, along with the rest of the Founders, would be outraged at the modern press' behavior. They did not intend its freedom to be a license to lie.**

“We are, heart and soul, friends to the freedom of the press. It is however, the prostituted companion of liberty, and somehow or other, we know not how, its efficient auxiliary. It follows the substance like its shade; but while a man walks erect, he may observe that his shadow is almost always in the dirt. It corrupts, it deceives, it inflames. It strips virtue of her honors, and lends to faction its wildfire and its poisoned arms, and in the end is its own enemy and the usurper's ally, It would be easy to enlarge on its evils. They are in England, they are here, they are everywhere. It is a precious pest, and a necessary mischief, and there would be no liberty without it.” Fisher Ames, *Review of the Pamphlet on the State of the British Constitution*, 1807.

This Founder's quote is longer than usual, but as is the case with Fisher Ames' musings, he has brilliantly captured the necessity and paradox of a free press. If we do not have freedom of the press, then we do not have liberty. A free press must be alive and well to keep WE the People informed of the actions of our elected officials.

However, and while I admit bias was not absent in our nation's beginning, today's mainstream media has become the public affairs office for the Democrat Party. In August 2016, New York Times columnist Jim Rutenberg [admitted](#) that journalistic standards may have to become oppositional to then Candidate Trump because they deemed him dangerous.
