Finally a group of pastors has called for the impeachment of our lawless US Attorney General Eric Holder. While it is encouraging that the Coalition of African-American Pastors (CAAP) are [calling](#) for the impeachment of Holder, it is highly unlikely the current Speaker of the House John Boehner has the courage of conviction to even entertain such an idea.

In our very first [edition](#) of The Truth Newsletter back on July 11, 2011, we called on Eric Holder to resign as Attorney General because he had “been caught in a boldface lie about his knowledge of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, & Firearms (BATF) and its Operation Gun Runner.”

Since then, Eric Holder has committed “a long train of abuses and usurpations,” of the sort our Founding Fathers found proper to dissolve themselves as British

subjects and form a new nation. It would be a nation of laws. This new nation would prevent us from ever again being abused as such as we were under “the present King of Great Britain” who had “a history of repeated injuries and usurpations, all having in direct object the establishment of an absolute Tyranny.”

For Barack Obama and Eric Holder to openly defy the US Constitution, established law, and the rights of WE the People is to display disdain for such. Obama is a tyrant and Holder is his henchman.

However, our Constitution was written as a means of never again having to take armed conflict against a sitting government. We have the power to overthrow a Congress that refuses to hold the Executive Branch accountable. The power of the ballot box and our unalienable rights as outlined in the Bill of Rights are the defenses against tyranny. The question is: will we wake up in time to save our union. Time is short.

FROM THE FOUNDERS



Had Eric Holder been our first Attorney General and told the 13 state attorneys general to not enforce a federal law, would have been met with the first immediate impeachment of a federal officer. However, I think President George Washington would have demanded his immediate resignation.

“The accumulation of all powers, legislative, executive, and judiciary, in the same hands, whether of one, a few, or many, and whether hereditary, self-appointed, or elective, may justly be pronounced the very definition of tyranny.” James Madison, [Federalist #47](#)

There have been a [total](#) of 19 impeachments of federal officials, consisting of 2 sitting Presidents, an Associate Justice of the US Supreme Court, a Secretary of War, a US Senator, and 14 federal judges. Eleven were either convicted in the US Senate and removed or resigned from office. The Senate refused to accept the impeachment of US Senator William Blount of Tennessee and expelled him from the Senate. I particularly like that 14 federal judges have been held accountable for high crimes and misdemeanors.

Whenever a federal official abuses the power enumerated to him or her, then that official must either be forced to resign or removed from office. To allow a sitting President and Attorney General to get away with blatant lawlessness such as the two we have today is to allow abuse and usurpation of the power that only WE the People have.

James Madison knew that we were of a fallen nature and because we were not angels we would need checks and balances against our sinful natures. He wrote in [Federalist #10](#):

“Enlightened statesmen will not always be at the helm.”

Abuses of power were not to be the expected norm. Statesmanship and respect for the law would be the ruling principles of our new nation. The further we slip from this truth, the closer we get to tyranny. In fact, we are already there.

FROM THE PULPIT

“Lawlessness is a condition in which no moral boundary, restraint, standard, rule is acknowledged or recognized as absolute, but here is the twist. Sin uses boundaries. It uses restraints. It uses standards. It uses rules. It uses codes of conduct for its own destructive purposes. Rather pernicious...But what is most disturbing is that sin can show itself to be the most law abiding and religious while it remains lawless.” Reverend William Kessler, “The Nature of Sin as Lawlessness” [sermon](#), Grace Presbyterian Church, Columbus, Ohio, October 8, 2006.

We have sinful men and women in the halls of government. This is not a new phenomenon. We’ve always had sinners representing us. However, the level of open lawlessness apparent in the current administration is more insidious than ever. As Rev. Kessler describes, this lawlessness is using the boundaries and restraints of government to violate individual liberty. It is using rules and regulations to require of WE the People that which we would never agree to in an open election.

What is worse is we have elected officials, who proclaim to follow the God of the Bible, and yet they sit back not only allowing such lawlessness, but also financing it.

Psalm 119 is titled, “Meditations on the Excellencies of the Word of God,” and in it the psalmist writes:

“It is time for You to act, O Lord, for they have regarded Your law as void.” (Psalm 119:126)

Let there be no doubt in our minds; if we do not act as citizens to at least counter, if not correct, the wickedness in our nation, then God will surely act. The Body of Christ in churches across America needs to repent of our individual and corporate sins, recommit our lives to serving God Almighty, and take a bold stand for the aletheia truth.

The great pre-Revolutionary revivalist preacher Jonathan Edwards, preaching on Romans 3:19 in a message titled “The Justice of God in the Damnation of Sinners” [wrote](#):

“The things that the law says, are sufficient to stop the mouths of all mankind...from making any excuse for ourselves, or objection against the execution of the sentence of the law, or the infliction of the punishment that it threatens.”

Lawlessness will be punished, with or without the aid of mankind.

TO THE STREETS

WE the People need to join the good ministers of CAAP in calling for the impeachment of Eric Holder. It is only through a peaceful movement of the electorate that Congress will heed our wishes. We must let Barack Obama, Eric Holder, and Congress know that we will no longer tolerate lawlessness. Where better to start than throwing out of office the man who is the Chief Law Enforcement Officer of the land? Eric Holder is advising state attorneys general to do the opposite. Clearly Eric Holder has no respect for the law and he must be removed.

Here are some steps to take to hasten his departure:

1. Please visit the Coalition of African American Pastors (CAAP) and [sign](#) the petition calling for Attorney General Eric Holder's impeachment.
2. [Contact](#) your US Representatives and inform him or her that you have signed the petition and want action taking on this petition.
3. [Contact](#) your two US Senators and inform them that should the US House of Representatives send articles of impeachment to the Senate, that you expect both of them to vote for Holder's removal from office.
4. Your US Representative is most likely running for re-election. If this is so, or if any candidate is running for Congress, demand that they commit to removing Eric Holder from office.
5. Check this [list](#) to see if your US Senator is up for re-election. Let the Senator know that you expect to see him or her push for Eric Holder's removal.
6. Encourage your friends, relatives, associates, and neighbors to join you in steps 1 thru 5 and let's really get Washington DC's attention.
