



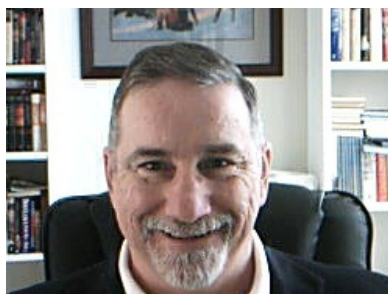

The Department of Justice’s website describes the office of the Attorney

Why our Founders expected virtuous men to serve in government:

“Have you ever found in history, one single example of a Nation thoroughly corrupted that was afterwards restored to virtue?...And without virtue, there can be no political liberty.”

John Adams in a letter to Thomas Jefferson

Our nation has a republican form of government that is founded on the rule of law, not of men. The Founding Fathers had personally experienced corruption from the Crown of England that manifested itself in tyranny.

Those who would lie and abuse the powers of government entrusted to them are agents of tyranny. We can no more tolerate equivocators and impostors in government who are sent to serve the people than we would sanction a military coup d’etat.

Project Gunrunner is far more egregious to our nation’s well-being than ten Watergate scandals. Whether or not Barack Obama or Eric Holder originally knew of the illegal movement of arms to drug runners in Mexico is of no difference.

The fact is Holder has been caught in a lie and we cannot tolerate such actions from the chief legal officer of the land.

FROM THE PULPIT

“In times past the greatness of America has been reflected in the integrity of her people. Many things have contributed to America’s greatness: a favorable climate, almost unlimited natural resources, the stimulating free-enterprise system, and a favorable form of government. However, nothing has been more significant in the success of our land than the spiritual resources of her people. In recent decades, however, it appears that we have lost a great deal of the moral strength which made our nation great.” A sermon delivered by Batsell Barrett Baxter on April 27, 1970 at the Hillsboro Church of Christ, Nashville, TN

It is hard to believe that Pastor Baxter spoke those words over 41 years ago. He could have said them last Sunday. With liberty comes duty. That’s not a concept being touted today! Duty alludes to a sense of responsibility and today personal responsibility does not sell very well in America. It is never the fault of the individual after all.

I wonder what a speech from Barack Obama would sound like were he addressing a scandal such as Project Gunrunner? How about Obama’s [remarks](#) welcoming his senior staff and cabinet secretaries on January 21, 2009, the day after his inauguration?

I will also hold myself as President to a new standard of openness. Going forward, anytime the American people want to know something that I or a former President wants to withhold, we will have to consult with the Attorney General and the White House Counsel, whose business it is to ensure compliance with the rule of law. Information will not be withheld just because I say so. It will be withheld because a separate authority believes my request is well grounded in the Constitution.

Let me say it as simply as I can: Transparency and the rule of law will be the touchstones of this presidency.

Very well then Mr. Obama, WE the People want to know what and when Mr. Holder and you knew about Project Gunrunner. Prove to us that information will not be withheld just because you, or as reports have suggested Mr. Holder, said so.

Pastor Baxter is right; our greatness as a nation has been reflected in the greatness of our people. That greatness can be restored to its once lofty position, but only when citizens demand righteousness from its government. This is as good of place to start as any.

TO THE STREETS

So here is where we can start demanding righteousness from our government. Please take the following steps and as always please be firm but courteous.

1. [Contact](#) the Justice Department and demand that Attorney General Holder resign and that all information, not vital to national security, be released.
2. Because it is unlikely that AG Holder will resign, contact the White House and demand that Barack Obama ask for Holder's resignation. You can leave a comment at 202-456-1111 or [email](#) the White House.
3. Because it is unlikely Obama will ask for Holder's resignation, [contact](#) your US Representative and your [two](#) US Senators and demand that they ask for AG Holder's resignation.
4. Write a letter to the editor of your local newspaper give some background on Project Gunrunner and public demand AG Eric Holder resign. Inform the public that dishonesty from our government officials will no longer be tolerated.
5. Call your local talk radio host to find out how much this is being covered locally, and if it is not being covered, encourage them to do so. Offer to provide them information and if you want, you can direct them to me.

We need to do all five steps provided above. Each one will not take much time and even if it did take a little of our time, is it not a good investment?

WE the People must demand righteousness from our government!

The Bible declares in Proverbs 14:34 that "Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a reproach to any people."

How long will we accept such deceit and dishonesty from our government?

We do not have the luxury of waiting until November 2012 to throw the bums out.

The bums need to leave, and they need to leave now.

We can start with the one at the head of the Justice Department.
